**U.S. Department of Education:** Each of our three schools has received national recognition for excellence in education as a Blue Ribbon School, most recently in 2016.

**National Board Certification®:** Sixteen District 103 staff members have achieved the prestigious recognition from the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards.
