LINCOLNSHIRE-PRAIRIE VIEW SCHOOL DISTRICT 103 OFFERS EARLY CHILDHOOD COMMUNITY PEER PROGRAM, A BLENDED PRESCHOOL OPTION

District 103 will offer Early Childhood (EC) Community Peer classes during the 2017-2018 school year. This program is held at Laura B. Sprague School for 3-4 year old children who live in the district.

Characteristics of our EC Community Peer program, a blended Pre-K model, include:

- 5 days a week, Monday-Friday.
 - Morning classes, 8:30 a.m.-11:00 a.m.
 - Afternoon classes, 12:00 p.m.-2:30 p.m.
- Tuition will be \$2,958 for the school year
- Small classroom size
- Certified teachers with degrees in Early Childhood Education
- Strong team of specialists to support classroom
- Developmentally-appropriate curriculum
 - Literacy
 - Math
 - Social-Emotional
 - Science

Benefits for Community Peer students follow:

- Build familiarity with Laura B. Sprague School prior to Kindergarten
- Participation in “specials” (i.e., physical education, music and library) taught by Sprague staff
- Participate in “centers” instructed by support personnel (i.e., specialists in speech/language, occupational therapy and social work)
- Attend developmentally appropriate school assemblies and events
- Opportunities to informally interact with Kindergarten teachers and classrooms
