

## Grade 8 First Stage Children's Theatre Trip



On Tuesday, October 29, 2019 the eighth grade is taking a field trip to the First Stage Children's Theatre in Milwaukee to the world premiere production of "On the Wings of a Mariposa." This is a bilingual performance about the importance of family. Here is a synopsis of the production:

"Ten-year old Pilar breathes deeply of her grandmother's rebozo to relive memories of her beloved abuelita - making corn tortillas, dueling the monsters under the bed and journeying to the forest known as El Circulo Magico. Slowly, the scent begins to fade - and with it, Pilar's memories. Amidst the monarch butterflies' annual migration and Dia de los Muertos celebrations, soar with Pilar on her journey in the bilingual world premiere play, discovering that "when you love someone, they never really leave you."

We will leave Daniel Wright at 9:30 a.m. and returning to school around 2:30 p.m. All students must bring a sack lunch and drink. We will eat on the Milwaukee Riverwalk directly in front of the theatre. There will not be access to microwaves or food vendors.

This trip is chaperoned by teachers and staff. The cost is \$21.00 which includes the First Student bus transportation cost and the theatre ticket.

Students should wear appropriate clothing to the theatre. Teachers will advise students who have questions about attire. Cell phones must be out of sight, and powered off while on the bus, outside and inside the theatre.

**Registration opens on September 10. The deadline to register and to make the payment is October 8.**
