Wednesday Classes (Dates: 4/8, 4/15, 4/22, 4/29, 5/6, 5/13)

CODE EXPLORERS (Kindergarten & 1st grade students) – 16 students

Are you tired of playing computer games and want to design your own? Do you love robotics? Did you enjoy participating in the 'Hour of Code' activities this year? If you answered yes to any of these questions, then Code Explorers is for you! The goal of this activity is to provide a fun introduction to computer science. You will use your iPad to learn how to create your own stories, games, and animations. You will also learn how to program Sprague's robotic friends, Dash and Dot.

LEARN TO DRAW (Kindergarten, 1st & 2nd grade students) – 14 students

Do you like to draw and want to learn some new skills? Well then this is the perfect place for you! Each week students will learn to draw with step by step tutorials. These exercises will help students to build their fine motor skills and gain confidence to present their creativity through art.

Thursday Classes (Dates: 4/9, 4/16, 4/23, 4/30, 5/7, 5/14)

CODE CRAFTERS (2nd grade only) – 20 students

If you love coding and Minecraft then Code Crafters is for you! During this activity, you will be using Microsoft MakeCode and Minecraft: Education Edition to learn how to use fundamental computer science concepts such as events, conditionals, functions, iterations, and variables. You will use your new skills to build fun code-driven projects in Minecraft. Prior experience with Minecraft is encouraged.

HANDS ON ANIMAL ART – (Kindergarten, 1st & 2nd grade students) – 14 students

Join us as we learn about animals through this interactive art class! Each week students will learn about a different animal and engage in hands-on arts and craft project inspired by their new animal friend. These exercises will help students build their fine motor skills and use their imaginations to create a masterpiece.

If the minimum is not met to hold a class, we will refund your payment. There is also a maximum number of students for each activity, which differs depending on the class.
